THIS MARBLE PANEL ILLUSTRATES A CHARACTERISTICALLY VENETIAN AMALGAM OF BYZANTINE DETAILS WITHIN A GOTHIC ARCHITECTURAL FRAMEWORK. BY THE END OF THE 13TH CENTURY VENICE HAD ADOPTED A COSMOPOLITAN MEDITERRANEAN ARCHITECTURAL IMAGERY WITH VARIOUS EUROPEAN, AND A FEW ISLAMIC ELEMENTS, BLENDED INTO ECCLESIASTICAL DECORATION IN A UNIQUE AND CREATIVE MANNER.
