THE POWER OR 'MANA' OF CERTAIN MAORI JADE WEAPONS, ACCORDING TO TRADITIONAL HISTORIES, WAS SO GREAT THAT SOME IMPORTANT WARRIORS KNOWING THEIR END WAS NEAR ASKED TO BE DISPATCHED BY A FAMOUS WEAPON, OR SUPPLIED THEIR OWN ILLUSTRIOUS CLUB TO THE EXECUTIONER, TO BE SURE PASS INTO THE NEXT WORLD WITH DIGNITY AND HONOUR.
